

NMHC Top 50 Unit Count Trend



Leasing Case Study - Charlesgate

Problem:

Operators hire leasing agents and charge them back to properties

Agents tied to properties: effective ones run out of units to sell

Multifamily treats leasing as a "training problem"

Solution:


Don't charge back salary costs - pay the operator for leases

That enables talent to go wherever leases need to be closed

Model allows operators to focus on hiring and developing sales talent




